

 - A. Before 1803, this nation's eastern and western boundaries were defined by the Atlantic Ocean and Mississippi River. Label and Color Green.
 - B. Jefferson sent representatives to France to buy this city. Label city.
 - C. This mountain range is North America's continental divide. Label and use triangle (^) symbol to represent.
 - This territory was claimed by Britain, Russia, Spain, and the United States.
 Label and Color Blue.
 - E. Napoleon sold the United States this territory in order to finance his European wars. Label and color Orange.

- F. The Rio Grande and the Great Salt Lake were two bodies of water in this region. Label and Color Red.
